The Work Group reviewed a March 9 draft policy outline and recommended expanding the section on 'law enforcement exemptions' to 'exemptions' more generally and adding a final section on 'handling sensitive information'.

Ald. Kemble and Ald. Baldeh will discuss the survey with the Mayor on March 14th at the Council Leadership meeting.

The survey is likely to be distributed on March 20. The survey deadline will be the end of May.

Herb King will provide a presentation of IT capabilities including cameras at the next meeting on March 28th. Future presentations will come from Metro, MPD and other agencies.
