WELCOME & OVERVIEW OF THE INTERVIEW AND SELECTION PROCESS

- Ald. Samba Baldeh, Chair, CCEC

Ald. Samba Baldeh welcomed the applicants and the public to the meeting. He then provided an overview of the process for the applicants and the members of CCEC. There would be two rounds of questions.

Round 1

Each applicant was provided with three questions prior to the meeting. Each applicant would have 5 minutes to speak.

There may be questions from any alder in attendance, not just from CCEC members. The chair would recognize anyone wishing to ask a question of the applicant before asking his or her question. When the applicant had finished their Round 1 questions, they could stay in the room. At the end of Round 1, there would be a recess and CCEC members would fill out their scoring sheets, turn them into to be tallied by Council staff. The results would be announced

by the Council President. In the event of a tie, an additional question would be asked. If there was no tie, the top three scoring applicants would move onto second round of questioning.

Round 2

At the end of Round 2, there would be a recess and CCEC members would fill out their scoring sheets, turn them into to be tallied by Council staff. Once tallied, the results would be given to the chair to be announced. In the event of a tie in Round 2, CCEC members would debate the results.
