1. <u>55935</u>

Authorizing the City to accept an award of \$93,891 from HUD's 2018 Continuum of Care (CoC) Program competition; amending the Community Development Division's 2019 Adopted Operating Budget as appropriate; and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into agreements necessary to accept the funds.
