Amending the Purchase and Sale Agreement with Madison Merchant Real Estate, Inc. ("Buyer") for the sale of Lot 4 CSM No. 14573 ("Site"), located within the Center for Industry and Commerce ("CIC"), for the purpose of accommodating additional stormwater management construction costs by alleviating the requirement of Buyer to pay approximately \$421,229 of special assessments at closing, and amending the City's Special Assessment Fund budget to provide Buyer with an additional \$432,206 to use toward stormwater management construction.
