Kevin Seton of Affiliated Engineers is seeking an exception to local lighting control as required by Wisconsin Chapter SPS 363 in cGMP contractor development and manufacturing (CDMO) in a laboratory space. The specific section being petitioned is 9.4.1 (a) in ASHRAE 90.1 2013 for local control requirement in laboratory and corridor space types as defined in Table 9.6.1. Alder District 10

Kevin Seton and Ryan Kallies of Affiliated Engineers as well as Chad Grindle of Cellular Dynamics made their presentation to the Board. The presentation focused on the products required to maintain the clean rooms and the effects the products will have on the local controls for the clean room lighting. The products will quickly degrade the local lighting controls in the clean rooms. Access to the clean rooms is highly restricted and the limited employees will all carry tablets to access local lighting controls as well as other features. They presented this as an equivalency.

Members of the Board asked the presenters numerous questions after which the Board deliberated the proposal. Olson made a motion, seconded by Brown to approve the variance to allow the use of tablets in the clean rooms only in place of local lighting controls. Motion passed unanimously.
