1. <u>54761</u>

Granting Special Vending Approvals under MGO 9.13(6)(k) for 2019 Special Events as detailed on the accompanying special event resolution table.

Verveer moved, second by Wood, to adopt with an amendment for item 1 on the Special Event Resolution spreadsheet for the Madison Night Market to include the sidewalks on the 100 to 600 blocks of State St., not including the 30 on the Square and east of the crosswalk at the top of 100 State, beginning at 2p on 6/13, 8/8 and 9/12. State Street will remain open to busses and other City authorized vehicles. The motion was passed by a voice vote/other.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

2. <u>52965</u> Allowing full size food trucks in Madison, outside high density vending zones.

Staff reviewed further research on truck sizes and additional research that is needed to be completed before bringing a formal document to the next meeting.

3. <u>54812</u> Discuss "extended delivery" in and around State St. Mall and Southeast Campus.

Staff reviewed the continued research being done on extended delivery. Given the customer base and restaurants represented staff will be gathering a group to do a RESJI Fast Track review prior to bringing recommendations forward to the next meeting.
