MANTOVA: Alfano reported that the Madison-Mantova Sister City (MMSC) sent Christmas gifts to city officials of Mantova including UW "Bucky" scarves.

TEPATITLÁN: Carranza gave update on mural project in Tepa. Three full walls in a high school have been designated for the mural - Lupe Rios will coordinate. Four artists from Madison will travel there in February, 2020 and there will possibly be a grand opening in May or June, 2020. The principal of this high school is interested in setting up a student exchange program with

#### Madison.

VILNIUS: Participated in Kennedy Elementary School's International Night in November. Zemliauskas-Juozevicius announced that the annual Madison-Vilnius Sister City (MVSC) Christmas Eve celebration will take place on Sunday, December 15 at St. Dennis School in Madison. She invited SCCC members to take part.

BAHIR DAR: Desalegne reported that there has been a connection made with a professor at a university in Bahir Dar to work with the Limnology Dept. at UW. They are working on a grant to bring that professor to Madison.

FREIBURG: James announced that Madison-Freiburg Sister City (MFSC) will be holding its Annual Dinner and Meeting at the University Club on Thursday, Feb. 18, 2020. SCCC members are invited as their guests.

MFSC participated in Kennedy School's International Night in November. James contacted Madison Maennerchor re: performance at Celebrate Madison's Sister City event in May. They have agreed. Size of choir, number of songs TBD.

MFSC's next meeting will be held on December 9, all are welcome to attend. Will be held at the home of John and Barbara DeMain.

Freiburg's Sister City Fest will be held in Freiburg in July, 2020. Mayor Rhodes-Conway has indicated that she will attend. Fest organizers request that art from Madison be on display. James will look into acquiring works from ArtWorking.

KANIFING: Baldeh/Jallow report that Madison-Kanifing Sister City (MKSC) is raising funds to build a library on land that has already been purchased in Kanifing. There has been a group here meeting every other week including the library system head, builders of libraries, and the UW Library specialist to discuss this project. Kanifing's mayor has invited Mayor Rhodes-Conway to visit. MKSC is planning a group trip to Kanifing next year.

ARCATAO: (submitted via email) Gantner announced that Madison-Arcatao Sister City Project (MASCP) participated in a Fair Trade Holiday Fair in November and will do so again on December 7, 2019 at Monona Terrace. MASCP sells embroidery items, tree ornaments, jewelry, and many other gifts created in Arcatao.
