-Pinney Library,six finalists have been selected for the two public art pieces. Artists should be select by June 2019 and art should be installed by Spring 2020.

-Momental by Jeff Repko, has been fabricated and is in storage, organizers are working to install the base. Sculpture should be in by the middle of Summer.
