Presenters: Robin Sereno, Chair, Homeless Services Consortium Committee to End Youth Homelessness. Sharita Holden, Shanon Holmes, members, Homeless Services Consortium Youth Action Board.

Sharita Holden, member of the Youth Action Board for the Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program, shared her concerns with youth aging out of community resources and not knowing where to go for support. Some youth are not able to stay with parents after they turn 18 because of lease or housing requirements for the parent as the lease holder. Information about the system while youth are still in school would be helpful.

Shanon Holmes, member of the Youth Action Board for the Homeless Services Consortium, spoke of the importance of school staff being aware of resources for youth and being comfortable communicating with youth about resources that exist.
