4. <u>28584</u> Review of Arts Budget

Staff reviewed Mayor's proposed budget and Ald. Carter budget amendment:

Room Tax: \$127,500

- Dane Dances \$25,000 (same level as 2018)
- Make Music Madison \$30,000 (same level as 2019)
- Between the Waves Songwriting Conference \$25,000 (same level as 2019)
- Wisconsin Stage at Folk Alliance International Conference in New Orleans \$2,500 (new request)
- Fairs/Festivals/Summer Concerts \$15,000 (same level since 2018)
- Blink + (Temporary Public Art for Downtown Doors \$10,000 and Public Market \$20,000)
 \$30,000 (requesting \$10,000 increase 2020)

Capital Budget: \$40,000, Carter proposed an additional \$60,000 for at Total of \$100,000 No expected changes in Operating Budget.
