**SPECIAL ITEMS OF BUSINESS**

The committee took a moment of silence for George Floyd and other African-Americans across the United States of America murdered without consequence.

Acting Police Chief Wahl, Fire Chief Davis, Assistant Fire Chief Price and Stedman shared updates on the protests, looting, damage, the departments response and the impacts to their department to the unrest occurring in the City.

Chair Konkel made a suggestion to combine items number 2b and agenda item #1 to form a subcommittee. This will be discussed further during item#1.

Chair Konkel inquired with the committee for the sake of time if the committee would like to combine item #3C with item #7 to be discussed together as the items go along with each other. The committee unanimously agreed. With the recent events and with the mission and charge of the committee to have oversight and input on the police and fire budgets, Chair Konkel inquired if any committee members would have interest in forming a subcommittee to work with City Finance, Police and Fire on the department budgets and report back to the committee. Mitnick made a motion on the creation of a budget subcommittee. Anglim seconded a motion. Mitnick, Alder Heck, and Chair Konkel volunteered to serve on the subcommittee. The notice will also be shared with others who may be interested in participating.
