Assistant Fire Chief Burrus (AC), Assistant Fire Chief Art Price, and Fire Finance Manager Nicole Marie Hall shared information on the capital improvement plan and operating budget details. Information was shared from the attached documents. Alder Heck inquired on an increase in ambulance fees and if it would put the city in mid-range to other Dane County Emergency Medical Team (EMT) providers. He also asked if there is a comparison number of greater EMS numbers in Wisconsin, nationally or if it is within mid-range for the state. AC Burrus said she is aware of Dane County providers only and they are in the mid-range. Alder Harrington McKinney inquired with the overall reduction of five percent the Mayor has proposed for agencies and how does that reflect the response times and her second question was with bringing in the Town of Madison what is the projected costs and what is the effect of bringing or not bringing into the city. AC Burrus responded all the stations would still be staffed so there would not be a reduction in response times however when assisting in outlying areas that may be impacted. It may affect those with the 2 in 2 out rule and it may make a difference in what they could do with the number of people on the scene. With regard to the Town and with the addition of the medic unit and the two fire stations close by there would not be a delay in service. Nicole Marie Hall indicated there would be a resolution coming along as the Town of Madison was not taken into consideration when the 2021 budget was imposed. Rickey inquired when the team is reduced is there any increased risk for the fire fighters. AC Price said the impacts could be response time and it also reduces the capability of support but this is also one of the ways they are trying to get around without reducing response. Rickey inquired about the contract and the number of people on the scene. Price shared there is a low, medium, and high risk plan. Burrus said with the contract there needs to be discussion and it would also need to be mutually agreed upon if any changes. Myadze asked with a reduction of staff and when police and fire show up together at the call has there been a discussion on the potential impacts. AC Price shared there could be a delay and this could be a safety issue for staff and the public. Alder Heck inquired on how many times in a day that would require four staff to attend to a structure fire. AC Price indicated the attached documents share this information. Konkel inquired about the increase in ambulance fees and the impacts. Nicole Marie Hall shared there is a waiver program. Konkel inquired on overtime and if protests have impacted this. Nicole Marie Hall shared because of the overtime events they would have been involved with and the cancellation of those because of COVID they are still within their overtime budget. Konkel inquired if this should be on the next agenda or a discussion item at the September meeting. Alder Harrington McKinney requested to have this item to be discussed further at the September meeting. Myadze seconded the motion.

Konkel inquired about something she heard with the use of tear gas. AC Price shared this would not be a request the Fire Department would normally make. AC Price shared he was given the article and will read it and share information

relating to tear gas at the September meeting.

AC Price indicated at this time they don't have anyone to speak to this agenda item. They do not have a mental health ambulance unit but that he would ask AC Stedman to get involved as he would have the data. Alder Harrington McKinney inquired if mental health transports default to the police department for questions or would be directed to the fire department. AC Burrus shared both departments are working to figure out what it would look like. Ian Olson inquired if he could speak on this agenda item. There were no objections from the committee. Mr. Olson shared his personal story on transports and working with the police department. Konkel shared to add mental health ambulance to the September agenda to discuss further.
