The Financial Navigator program has had a soft launch and is available to the public.

Summer Jobs Connect is a Citites for Financial Empowerment grant we received, and the planning will start on Friday. The goal is to build a collaborative approach to financial empowerment for youth.

Our Dream Up team was awarded \$500,000 to continue with their employee advancement work. The goal is to increase the income of 10,000 people by 10%.
