## 2. <u>32522</u> Review Overture Contract

Members of MAC expressed sadness to learn of Sandra Gajic's death in December. MAC will work with Overture Board and staff, and City staff, to facilitate community and stakeholder meetings that may inform the next structural agreement. MAC members expressed concern that name of the Community Advisory Board (CAB) was changed to a "Community Advisory Committee" without discussion with the CAB, members would like the renaming of the CAB to be reconsidered. MAC members recommended bringing Barb Schrank on board and paying her to help facilitate.

## 3. <u>37957</u> Art for Public Market

MAC members would like to see the public art plan include: 1) Hiring a diverse curatorial team to select the artist, 2)Eric Adjetay Anang designing a piece for the Children's Area of

the Market, and 3) Purchasing a sponsorship tier with Momentum Art Techs in order for the 11 garage stalls to be part of Momentum's Street Art Festival. MAC will consider a dollar amount for the RFQ after staff brings forth a concrete proposal for the location and scope of the Percent for Art Funded piece.

MAC Honors Event will be held at Garver Feed Mill on January 9 from 6:00pm-8:00pm. Bethany Jurewicz arranged for Garver to host the event at a deeply discounted rate.
