DISCUSSION ITEMS

3. 62629 Discussion of Draft Resolution on Referendum Items

The committee discussed the format of a resolution to the Common Council to bring questions about the size of the Council to public referendum. They discussed the question of advisory and binding referenda, and provided feedback to Assistant City Attorney John Strange regarding the wording of the resolution.

Alder Foster moved to bring resolution option #3 (advisory referendum on the April ballot) to the Council at the 11/17 meeting, with the understanding that it would also include language about holding a binding referendum in spring of 2022, Kemble seconded.

Alder Furman made a motion to amend the resolution language to include the language "If full-time" to the resolution language on term limits, Foster seconded, the amendment passed by unanimous consent.

A roll call vote was taken on the motion as amended:

Alder Foster: Aye Alder Kemble: Aye Alder Skidmore: No Alder Furman: Aye

With three Ayes and one No, the motion passes as amended.
