Q/A regarding vaccination, men's shelter operation, and new men's shelter design considerations.

Presenters provided an overview of the available services for youth, identified service gaps, housing challenges facing youth, system challenges, how homeless system is responding and various data points on the extent of youth homelessness. 4. Updates from the HSC Doubled Up Workgroup

Presenters provided information on the number of doubled up households identified by the school district, their unique vulnerability and challenges. Presenters also shared ideas on how to better support the doubled up families, including re-evaluating how the homeless services coordinated entry system assesses doubled up households, creating a homeless specialist position focusing on households who are doubled-up or self-paying in hotels or motels, and creating funding specific to serving doubled up households. Q/A including the system level challenges, barriers to housing and services, and different systems' definitions of homelessness.

Committee members requested a presentation from public health about vaccination for homeless population—how to prioritize one-dose vaccine for people who are experiencing homelessness and incarceration.

Committee requested staff report or presentation on the following items:

- Shelter needs for parenting minors-licensing restrictions, what can be done city-, county-, and state-level to meet this need, other models in the state
- Can hotel vouchers be provided for parenting minors beyond the pandemic?

Committee will try to schedule an additional meeting in May to have a follow-up discussion on these items.
