- 1. Remove the buffered bike lane/parking recommendations for Whitney Way to futher discuss and refer this issue to the Transportation Commission for a decision by the end of summer 2021
- 2. There will be no restrictions to left turning at the Rosa and Island intersections of Mineral Point Road
- 3. Continue to explore options for left turning restrictions at the intersections of Grand Canyon and

Westfield on Mineral Point Road and bring the Mineral Point Road item back to TPPB for decision by May 2021.
