Bill Connors, representing Smart Growth Greater Madison Inc., posed questions to members.

- a. Dan McAuliffe, Planning Division Planner, presented to Work Group members on impacted parcels.
- b. Kate Smith, Assistant City Attorney, & Heather Stouder, Planning Division Director, presented to Work Group members on the develelopment moratorium process & examples.

Alders raised questions on:

- Is Meqoun the only other example? (A: Other examples tied in other things.)
- There is a high bar to declare a moratorium, correct? (A: Yes, specific steps. Went into effect in 2012.)
- Has this been done in areas like Madison? What frequency has it been done? (A: Not in Madison. Counties can't do it.)
- Can moratorium be based on existing complaints? (A: Doctor, Registered Nurse, or Certified Engineer needs to take the stance that it poses a significant threat to public health & safety.)
- 12 month limit? (A: Yes, & needs to include why municipality needs 12 months. Possible 6 month extension after 12 months.)

c. Kate Smith, Assistant City Attorney, Matt Tucker, Building Inspection Division Director, & Heather Stouder, Planning Division Director, presented to Work Group members on options for regulating new residential construction & building form standards.

Alders raised questions on:

- Right now, there are tables by district of which [building] forms are allowed.... [Is] there any reason that couldn't happen [with an overlay district too]? (A: [The Alcohol Overlay District] does this, but it's a use-based restriction [not a building form restriction].)
- In terms of requiring a certain amount of decibel reduction... Can we not create something similar to the bird-safe glass requirements? (A: Min/max code prohibits that requirement.)
- Would the Legislature allow the City of Madison to do this through a carve-out in state statute? (A: Could pursue.)
