NEW BUSINESS

72031 115 King Street - Approval of a Mural for the Majestic Theater (Doty Street facing wall) in the Downtown Core. 4th Ald. Dist.

The Commission noted the following as the basis for their motion:

- The mechanical vent shall be removed as part of the wall maintenance and repairs being done prior to installation of the mural.
- The mural extents shall be from just above the doors to the top of the building and edge-to-edge on the wall. Consideration should be given to including a border around the mural.
- · There is a cohesiveness of painting with consistent color around the mural.
- Consideration should be given to removing the Capitol Building from the mural, or making the mural less of a nod to Madison.
- Consideration should be given to incorporating an educational aspect to Clyde more than just his appearance and drumsticks.

A motion was made by Knudson, seconded by Braun-Oddo, to Grant Final Approval. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

6. T2313 1841 Northport Drive - Planned Multi-Use Site, New Drive-Thru Restaurant. 12th Ald. Dist.

The motion provided for the following:

- · Replace the washed stone mulch with bark mulch.
- Consider angled parking in place of head-in parking along the north side of the building.
- Consider replacing the striping and bollards on the southside of the building with a curb barrier and landscaping.
- · Consider keeping the utility meters on the west side of the building.
- The Commission finds that a one-story building is acceptable given it size.

A motion was made by Klehr, seconded by Braun-Oddo, to Grant Final Approval. The motion passed by voice vote/other.
