- · Refine the masonry details.
- · Recess the guard railing at the rooftop terrace, or provide for plantings over the railing.
- · Replace the washed stone mulch with shredded bark/wood mulch.
- · Suggest switching the Arborvitaes to an upright Hicks Yew, using more colorful varieties of

Dervilla (Color Splash or Kodiak), adjust the spacing and quantities of ornamental grasses to

bulk them up, and add flowering perennials to the mix (Salvia, Black Eyed Susans).
