#### **CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL**

The meeting was called to order at 5:04pm. All participants appeared in person.

#### **DISCLOSURES AND RECUSALS**

There were no disclosures or recusals.

#### **EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

The complainant was not present at the start of the meeting.

The respondent, respondent's counsel, and respondent's witnesses were present.

President Schauf announced her intention to wait for 15 minutes for the complainant and any witnesses to arrive.

The complainant arrived at 5:11pm and the Hearing commenced.

A motion was made by Schauf, seconded by Boggess, to Convene into Closed Session pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 19.85(1)(a) (deliberating concerning a case which was the subject of a quasi-judicial hearing before the governmental

body) to consider the respondent's motion to dismiss.

The motion passed by voice vote/other.

The Commission convened into closed session at 5:35pm.

A motion was made by Boggess, seconded by Schauf, to Reconvene into open session. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

A motion was made by Schauf, seconded by Boggess, to hold the respondent's motion to dismiss in abeyance until the complainant completes the presentation of his case.

The motion passed by voice vote/other.

The evidentiary hearing resumed at 5:42pm.

A motion was made by Schauf, seconded by Greer, to Convene into Closed Session pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 19.85(1)(a) (deliberating concerning a case which was the subject of a quasi-judicial hearing before the governmental body) to consider the respondent's motion to dismiss and motion for summary judgement. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

The Commission convened into closed session at 6:38pm.

A motion was made by Schauf, seconded by Greer, to Reconvene into open session. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

The hearing resumed at 6:45pm.

A motion was made by Schauf, seconded by Greer, to Grant the respondent's motions and to dismiss the complaint with prejudice.

The Evidentiary Hearing was concluded.
