Declaring the City of Madison's intention to exercise its police powers establishing the Woodley Lane Assessment District - 2011. (14th AD)

Body

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

- That the Common Council of the City of Madison hereby establishes an assessment district known as the Woodley Lane Assessment District - 2011 to serve Woodley Lane from Waunona Way to the north end; all in accordance with Section 66.0701 (formerly Section 66.62) of the Wisconsin State Statutes and Section 4.09 of the Madison General Ordinances.
- That the contemplated purposes of this assessment district is to remove and replace the storm sewer and pavement, and install curb and gutter, drive aprons, and sidewalk as needed.
- That the benefited properties shall have the opportunity to pay the special assessments which may be levied as a result of this assessment district in eight (8) annual installments, subject to the current interest rate in effect at the time of establishment of the special assessment.
- That the City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare a report consisting of preliminary or final plans and specifications; an estimate of the entire cost of the proposed work or improvements within the assessment district; a schedule of proposed assessments, constituting an exercise of police power of the City of Madison; and a statement that the property against which the assessments are proposed is benefited.
- That upon completion of this aforesaid report, the City Engineer shall proceed in accordance with

Section 4.09 of the Madison General Ordinances.
