Pursuant to Sec. 3.27(2) of the Madison General Ordinances, " ... provisions of this section shall not necessarily apply with reference to membership on special study committees where in the judgment of the mayor and two-thirds (2/3) of the Common Council, the best interests of the city will be served by the appointment of certain nonresident members who are

particularly well qualified by reasons of education, background, and experience"
