Title

Amending Section 33.13(4)(c) of the Madison General Ordinances to Limit Other Referrals to the CCOC to Matters that are not within the Mission or Jurisdiction of another City Board, Commission or Committee.

Body

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: Sec. 33.13(4)(c), MGO, allows the Common Council to "assign other duties" to the Common Council Organizational Committee (CCOC). This ordinance limits any such referral or other duties to matters that do not fall within the mission or jurisdiction of another City Board, Commission or Committee.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subdivision (c) entitled "Other Duties" of Subsection (4) entitled "Duties of the Committee" of Section 33.13 entitled "Common Council Organizational Committee" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"(c) Other Duties. The Common Council may assign other duties to the Common Council Organizational Committee, provided, however, that no referral may be made or other duties assigned to the Common Council Organizational Committee if the matter falls within the mission or jurisdiction of another City board, commission or committee."
