**WHEREAS**, Madison is recognized as one of the most bicycle friendly communities in the country; and

**WHEREAS**, bicycling is a healthy, fun, inexpensive, environmentally sustainable, and community friendly form of transportation and recreation; and

**WHEREAS**, communities that are bicycle friendly are seen as having a high quality of life; and

**WHEREAS**, Madison should be seen as bicycle friendly simply for the fact that so many hardy souls commute by bike all winter; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Madison will submit an application for Bicycle Friendly Community status to the League of American Bicyclists; and

**WHEREAS**, the application for a Bicycle Friendly Community award from the League of American Bicyclists will mean an outside analysis of areas where we can improve our bicycle education, planning, facilities, and law enforcement;
