#### **Title**

The Madison Fire Department is requesting to amend the 2016 operating budget to receive a Homeland Security Grant Award through the WI Department of Military Affairs for \$56,825.70 to cover the cost of purchasing and placing into service <u>Standardized</u> HAZMAT Detection Equipment totaling \$56,825.70.

### **Body**

The WI Department of Military Affairs has awarded the City of Madison Fire Department a grant totaling \$56,825.70 for <u>LaBr</u> Detector, Radiation Alarming Personnel (Gamma and Neutron) for \$36,484.00 and a RadEye PRD Detector, Radiation Alarming Personnel (Gamma and Neutron) for \$20,341.70.

WHEREAS, Madison Fire Department has a contract with the State of Wisconsin as a Type II Hazardous Material Response Team and;

WHEREAS, the grant award requires purchasing of specified equipment and acceptance of award requires a

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sole source purchase to conform to a standardized equipment cache being established.

WHEREAS, the Department of Military Affairs has awarded the Madison Fire Department a grant of \$56,825.70 to purchase standardize monitoring equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the 2016 Operating Budget for the Madison Fire Department shall be amended to reflect receipt and expenditures of \$56,825.70 for the purposes and at the costs described above.
