The proposed resolution authorizes the award of Public Works Contract No. 8002, Forest Hill Cemetery Improvements 2017. The total estimated cost of the project is \$756,888. The Parks Division capital budget includes \$645,000 for Forest Hill Cemetery Improvements (Munis project 17167) and \$111,888 for Park Land Improvements (Munis project 17421) funded by GO Borrowing which will be used for this contract.
