**Fiscal Note**

The proposed resolution awards a \$1,242,000 contract with Amigo Construction, LLC for construction of the Park Edge/Park Ridge Employment Center. The 2018 Adopted Capital Budget created the Park Edge/Park Ridge Employment Center as a standalone project and transferred the balance of available funding from the Neighborhood Centers capital project to Park Edge/Park Ridge for a project total of \$1.6 million. Approximately \$1.5 million of project funding is still available for Park Edge/Park Ridge. No additional City appropriation is required.
