PREAMBLE

Pursuant to City Ordinances and policies, in 2008, the City Engineer advertised for consulting proposals, reviewed the submitted proposals, and the work was awarded to CGC, Inc. The City Engineer recommends that this contract be extended to provide the same work in 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a contract with CGC, Inc. for furnishing professional services to test asphalt pavement mixtures, concrete mixes, and soil compaction; investigate soils; drilling and well construction on various City of Madison Public Works Projects.

Fiscal Note

Total cost of these services is not to exceed \$300,000 unless the agreement is extended. The actual cost of the services will be assessed to individual public works projects and their respective account numbers.
