**Fiscal Note**

The Housing Operations 2007 Operating Budget funds the Director position at \$85,179. This contract stipulates an annual salary of \$91,029.60. The difference (including increased benefits) will be funded through a combination of salary savings, reallocation of federal funds, and/or reserves applied.
