**Title**

To SUSPEND the handcrafted goods and personally prepared food vending restrictions on June 9, 2012 during SAFETY SATURDAY and authorizing the Madison Fire Department, as sponsor of the special event, to select vendors, vending sites and performers for the duration of the event on the 10 blocks of E. Main St., the 10 blocks of N. & S. Pinckney and the 100 block of E. Washington Ave.

**Body**

WHEREAS, Section 9.13 (6) of the Madison General Ordinances and the regulations adopted therein control street vending on the State Street Mall/Capitol Concourse area; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.13 (6)(k)1. allows the Common Council to suspend specifically enumerated vending ordinances or regulations and establish alternate rules and procedures during a special event; and

WHEREAS, SAFETY SATURDAY is such a special event; and

WHEREAS, the sponsor of the event, the Madison Fire Department, wishes to suspend MGO Sec. 9.13(6)(b) regarding handcrafted, homemade goods; and

WHEREAS, no vending licenses or sidewalk cafe licenses will be invalidated and

WHEREAS, all licensed vendors holding Mall/Concourse licenses and assigned sites at the corners of E. Main and Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., E. Washington Ave. and N. & S. Pinckney St., within the perimeter of the event, will be relocated to a location on the State Street Mall/Concourse Area outside the perimeter of the event pursuant to the authority in Sec. 9.13(6)(k)5; and

WHEREAS, the event sponsor wishes to select additional vendors, salespersons and vending sites to sell products during the special event; and

WHEREAS, the Madison Fire Department agrees to limit any vendors selected by its event to selling promotional materials specifically related to the event; such as T-shirts, posters, souvenirs or other related items; and

WHEREAS, the event sponsor shall obtain a Special Event Vending License for all selected vendors, as required by sec. 9.13(2) and(3); and

WHEREAS, the Madison Fire Department agrees to obtain a Street Use Permit for Saturday, June 9, 2012 from 6:00a.m to 2:00p.m on the 10 blocks of E. Main St., the 10 blocks of N. & S. Pinckney and the 100 block of E. Washington Ave. and agrees to comply with the conditions of the permit, including but not limited to any conditions placed on the permit by the Street Use Staff Commission; and

WHEREAS, the sponsors agree to comply with all recommendations of the Street Use Staff Commission and Vending Coordinator concerning the location of vending sites and use of electricity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council hereby SUSPENDS the vending restrictions relating to handcrafted goods, personally prepared food set forth in 9.13(6)(b) of the Madison General Ordinances for the streets specifically described above for Saturday, June 9, 2012 from 6:00a.m to 2:00p.m.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Common Council establish an alternate rule for vending to allow the event sponsor the right to select additional vendors, salespersons and vending sites within the above described streets and sidewalks on Saturday, June 9, 2012 from 6:00a.m to 2:00p.m; subject to the conditions of the Street Use Permit for placement of vending sites and equipment.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Common Council establish alternate rules limiting any such vendors or sales persons to vending only food and beverages, and promotional goods or materials related to the event; such as T-shirts, posters, souvenirs or other related items sites within the above described streets and sidewalks on Saturday, June 9, 2012 from 6:00a.m to 2:00p.m.
