**Body**  
PREAMBLE

The Rosa Road Sidewalk project will provide a continuous sidewalk on the west side of Rosa Road from Elder Place to Old Sauk Road. The right-of-way currently does not have sidewalk and abuts City owned land and the backyard of one privately owned parcel. After the installation of this sidewalk the need for sidewalk on Rosa Road from Elder Place to Regent Street will be monitored and evaluated.

BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1) That the plans, specifications, and schedule of assessments for Rosa Road Sidewalk be and are hereby approved.
- 2) That the Board of Public Works be and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for said project.
- 3) That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to accept dedication of lands and/or easements from the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
