**Fiscal Note**

The proposed resolution authorizes a contract with Sarah Edgerton to serve as the Information Technology Director. The proposed five year contract begins in 2018 and commences in 2023. The proposed annual salary for the position is \$135,000. This position is fully funded in IT's 2018 Adopted Operating Budget and the 2019 Executive Budget.
