Fiscal Note

The Employment Agreement establishes an annual initial year's salary of \$122,679 beginning February 1, 2015. The Information Technology (IT) 2015 Operating Budget includes \$113,706 for the IT Director position. Sufficient funding will be provided by the management of salary savings. Annual salary adjustments may be made during the term of the agreement at the Mayor's discretion, subject to Common Council approval.
