WHEREAS, the Madison Memorial High School Spartans Boys Basketball Team finished the 2008-09 season with a 26-1 record, and earned their sixth straight Big Eight Conference title and sixth straight berth to the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association basketball tournament; and

WHEREAS, the Spartans defeated Bay Port in the semi-finals, earning a spot in the Division 1 Championship Game against Racine Horlick, who they defeated by a score of 56-41, with senior Jeronne Maymon, who was named the state's Mr. Basketball by the Wisconsin Basketball Coaches Association, scoring 25 points with 12 rebounds, while junior Vander Blue delivered 19 points and 11 rebounds; and,

WHEREAS, Coach Steve Collins and his assistant coaches emphasized teamwork and team spirit with the Spartans in blending their talents to capture the championship; and,

WHEREAS, the Madison community is proud of the excellence, teamwork, and dedication and spirit shown by the young men of the Spartan basketball team; and,
