Fiscal Note

This Ordinance (in conjunction with several others) makes permanent the metered parking on the Capital Square, following the 180-day trial period. All costs and revenues are recognized in the Parking Utility operating budget.

Title

Amending Subsection (453) of Section 12.132 entitled Parking Prohibited At All Times of the Madison General Ordinances (portion of Main Street).

Body

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This ordinance revises the Parking Prohibited At All Times on a portion of the south side of Main Street.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subsection (453) of Section 12.132 entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"(453) On the north side of Main Street from Butler Street to Pinckney Street and from Thornton Avenue to a point 238 feet east therefrom and on the south side from Carroll Street to Pinckney Street and from Martin Luther King, Jr., Boulevard, Thornton Avenue to a point 187 feet east therefrom and from South Hancock Street to a point 120 feet east therefrom."
