#### **Fiscal Note**

In the adopted 2016 capital budget the Sewer Utility budgeted \$2.3 million in the Trenchless Sewer Rehabilitation program (MUNIS 10450) for the rehabilitation of failing sewers through the process of lining the pipes remotely. The minor project for Cured In Place Piping (CIPP) is established with sufficient budget authority for the work in this proposed resolution (MUNIS 10800). Funding is provided by revenue bonds.

The proposed resolution awards the contract at an estimated total cost of \$410,780.
