**Fiscal Note**

Costs for the remainder of 2010 are estimated at \$375 of salary plus \$153 of benefits, for a total of \$528. Funding is available within the 2010 Engineering Operating Budget as a result of salary savings. Annualized costs for 2011 are projected at \$2,600 of salary and \$1,063 of benefits, for a total of \$3,663. This amount will be included in the 2011 Engineering Adopted Operating Budget.

**Title**
