### Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2016 capital budget Engineering - Facilities Management has budgeted \$4.8 million for the major MMB renovation project (MUNIS 10550). The minor project for the cost components of the MMB renovation is established with sufficient budget authority in 2016 for the work pertaining to hazardous material removal in this proposed resolution (MUNIS 10129). Funding is provided by GO borrowing.

The proposed resolution approves plan documents for the hazardous material removal at an estimated cost of \$270,000.
