**Fiscal Note**

The 2017 adopted capital budget includes \$1,290,000 for Park Land Improvements (Munis #17421) funded by GO Borrowing (\$993,000), Impact Fees (\$282,000), and private contributions (\$15,000). The proposed resolution authorizes the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for 2018 Parks Division Fencing and Backstops, estimated at \$153,700. Funding is available within the 2017 Park Land Improvements project.

BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1) That the plans and specifications for 2018 Parks Division Fencing and Backstops, be and are hereby approved.
- 2) That the Board of Public Works be and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for said project.
- 3) That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and grant easements or right-of-way release or procurement documents, maintenance agreements or encroachment agreements, as necessary and grant or accept dedication of lands and/or easements from/to the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
