WHEREAS, Pat Kreitzman is retiring on January 4, 2008 after 34 years of service to the City of Madison. Pat began her career as a Clerk Steno 1 for the Zoning Department on January 2, 1974. In 1978 she moved to doing payroll, purchasing and personnel work. Her job was reclassified to Administrative Clerk 1 in 1984 and on February 11, 1996 she was promoted to Program Assistant III. From that date she also served as the Secretary to the Director of the Division.

WHEREAS, during Pat's service to the City she helped facilitate the conversion of property files from envelopes to color coded files to microfiche to our current document imaging system. Pat's career also spanned a time from when permits were entered in to a ledger through several computerized tracking systems.
