WHEREAS, every tree planted, nurtured and/or maintained by past generations and enjoyed by citizens today, bears witness to the foresight of our predecessors- men and women who were inspired by the notion of a future endowed with trees; and

WHEREAS, trees in our City increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, beautify our community, and reduce costs to private and public concerns; and

WHEREAS, Madison has been recognized as a Tree City USA by the National Arbor Day Foundation for 19 consecutive years and received a Growth Award for 7 years, and desires to continue it's tree planting ways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Mayor of the City of Madison, Wisconsin, does hereby proclaim **April 21**st **thru 25**th **is Arbor Week 2008** in the City of Madison; and all citizens are urged to support the efforts to protect our trees and woodlands and to support our City's urban forestry program.
