Americas of NY; UBS AG Bank of NY; State St. Boston Bank & Co. of Boston; Chase Manhattan, qualified as public depositories under Chapter 34 of the Wisconsin Statutes, shall be and are hereby designated until further action, as public depositories for all public monies coming into the hands of the Treasurer of the City of Madison, Wisconsin.
