NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a Certified Survey Map of property owned by the University of Wisconsin Board of Regents located at 1552-1800 University Avenue, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, which has been duly filed for approval of the Madison Common Council, be and the same is hereby approved as required by Chapter 236, Wisconsin Statutes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Madison are hereby authorized to sign the certified survey, bond and subdivision contract, subsequent affidavits of corrections, parkland acquisition documents, easement or right-of-way release or procurement documents or any other related document or documents as deemed necessary by the Secretary of the Plan Commission in accordance with the approved Certified Survey Map.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all dedications included in this Certified Survey or required as a condition of approval of this Certified Survey be and are hereby accepted by the City of Madison.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the relocation of the proposed common lot line east to be located between the eastern wall of the Navy ROTC Building and the western wall of the proposed Wisconsin Energy Institute, or, the creation of a third lot for the Navy ROTC Building site to address the conditions of approval of the Certified Survey Map are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Planning Division is authorized to reflect the recorded Certified Survey

Map in the Comprehensive Plan and any applicable neighborhood plans.
