**Fiscal Note**

The proposed resolution awards the contract for North Blair Street at a total estimated cost of \$1,600,000. The adopted 2017 budget for Engineering-Major Streets contains the project's budget authority within the Reconstruction Streets capital program (MUNIS 11470), which was added to the program budget in 2017 via adoption of resolution #46519. Estimated project costs will be assigned to associated agencies as follows:

- Major Streets - \$940,000
- Sewer Utility - \$360,000
- Water Utility - \$300,000
