ARBOR WEEK PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Madison has been recognized as a Tree City USA by the Arbor Day Foundation for 22 consecutive years and desires to continue its tree planting ways; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, by the City of Madison that **April 24 thru 30** is Arbor Week 2011 in the City of Madison and all residents are urged to support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands and to support our City's urban forestry program.
