Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2016 capital budget, the Water Utility has budgeted \$11.7 million for the Water Mains Replace Rehab Improvements program (MUNIS 10432). The minor project for 2016 Cured-in-place piping (CIPP) Rehabilitation (MUNIS 11400) has available budget authority for the cost of the proposed resolution. The project supports replacement and upgrades of water mains to rehabilitate the aging infrastructure. Funding is provided through revenue bonds.

The proposed resolution approves plan documents at an estimated cost of \$1,289,800.
