WHEREAS, the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System (“University of Wisconsin”), shall be installing a utility tunnel within the right of way in Randall, Dayton, Charter & Johnson Streets under a Permit to Excavate in the Right of Way, and;

WHEREAS, staff from Parks, Traffic Engineering and City Engineering have reviewed the current amenities and recommend certain changes that may result in the same operational efficiencies and;

WHEREAS, The University of Wisconsin shall need to disturb the City right of way and shall restore Randall, Dayton, Charter & Johnson Streets in accordance with plans and specification that are incorporated in their approved Permit to Excavate in the Right of Way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the plans and specifications for the public improvements necessary for the restoration of Randall, Dayton, Charter & Johnson Streets shall be approved as part of the approval process for the Permit to Excavate in the Right of Way.
