Fiscal Note

As stated in the Employment Agreement between the City of Madison and John Tate, II Robert Copley, the Independent Police Monitor's salary will be based on a total annualized rate of \$125,000 \$122,000 effective November 14 December 5, 2022. The Independent Police Monitor position is approved and funded in the 2022 Adopted Operating Budget. Annual salary adjustments may be made during the term of the agreement at the Civilian Oversight Board's discretion, subject to Common Council approval.

WHEREAS, the Civilian Oversight Board has appointed John Tate II Robert Copley to the position of Independent Police Monitor and has recommended to the Common Council that their appointment be confirmed; and,
