**Fiscal Note**

Funds are available in the Acct. Nos. listed on the attached, with the exception of \$9,720 in expenditures relating to traffic signal infrastructure. While no additional general obligation borrowing is required and there are sufficient proceeds available in the capital budget of Traffic Engineering, the budget does not provide expenditure authority for this project. Therefore, an amendment to the Traffic Engineering capital budget is required to provide additional expenditure authority.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the 2009 adopted Traffic Engineering budget (project #7, "Traffic
